Programme description	<p>The first Inclusive Growth Development Policy Operation (DPO) in Georgia supports the government in its efforts to improve public service delivery and strengthen fiscal oversight (including development of ICT). These objectives will be achieved through reforms in the areas of public financial management, social sectors and the framework for civil services. The proposed policy actions are anchored in the Country Partnership Strategy (CPS) for 2014-17 and are consistent with the governments' new development strategy.</p> <p>While private sector development, which is being supported by another DPO series in Georgia, will help create more jobs, this DPO series will help build human capital and support macroeconomic stability and effective policy making. The policy matrix reflects reforms on multiple fronts and at various stages.</p>
